

Honors Physics Final 2008-09

You have 2 options when it comes to the final exam in Honors Physics this year.

Option 1: Written Exam

Take the written exam given at the end of the year. This will cover all topics during second semester. The format will be problems that the students will provide both Why?s and How?s. The exam will contain a large number of problems and students will have to complete **all** problems for full credit. **This exam is not eligible for the Senior Exemption policy.**

Option 2: Six Flags Exam

Go on the trip to Six Flags New England. Gather data at the park and do the packet after the trip. At the final exam time pass in your completed packet and take a 1 page Six Flags final. **The 1 page final in the only portion eligible for the Senior Exemption policy.**

Typical Questions

Q: What if I have a conflicting event on the day of the trip, like sports?

A: *Then you need to take the written exam or miss your other event.*

Q: Can my parents pick me up from the park early?

A: *Yes, with the agreement of your group and Mr. Cochran.*

Q: Do we work alone or in a group?

A: *You will work with a group, as we have done for labs this year.*

Q: When is the payment for the trip due?

A: *To reserve the tickets and busses all payments and forms are due to Mr. Cochran before March 25th.*

Q: How hard is the Written Exam?

A: *Very hard!*

Q: Can HWRHS students who are not in Mr. Cochran's classes come on the trip?

A: *Yes, but they need to speak to Mr. Cochran personally and be a "guest" of one of his students.*
