- A. Congratulations to the Administration, Jen Daniels, and Nancy Littlehale, on the playground operations @ Winthrop Elementary School. The opening was on Tuesday
- **B.** Curriculum night was this week; I attended Buker's and was well run.
- C. Josh Liebow & Gene Lee had an information meeting with David Winger and Alex Begin head of the Fin Coms, this was a meet and great to start communication and make personal introductions.

V. Superintendent's Report

- A. Eric Tracy announced Katherine Dixon and Phil Durgan were named "Commended Students in 2018 National Merit Scholarship Program". There are 2 of 34,000 in the nation to be commended; they placed in 5% of more than 1.5 million that entered the 2018 competition by taking he preliminary 2018 PSAT test.
- **B.** On September 27th the district presented an application to the Hamilton Conservation Commission to build (2) turf fields at the Regional High School. The Conservation Commission will be holding a site visit at the Regional on October 7th and will continue the public hearing on October 11th. This will be the last step in the permitting process.
- C. On September 19th I attended the Essex County District Attorney's "Policy Makers Forum"; the topic was "Kids in Crisis" a strategic approach and how to help identify traumatized youth. This was attended by School District leaders, public officials and members of the Massachusetts State Court Systems. They trained School Clinicians in administrating the UCLA a PTSD index tool used in identifying individuals of traumatic events.
- **D.** Nancy Bergner has submitted her resignation as the minute taker and the position has been posted to School Spring and currently I am in the process of interviewing.

VII. Discussion of Item Removed from Consent Agenda

A. Miles River Middle School Field Trip Request-Washington DC

Concern that the MS trip to DC would interfere with the senior week events; Mr. Craig Hovey explained the only dates of availability were May 29th and June 12th, he felt the Middle School Trip would not interfere with the events at the Regional High School. Mr. Hovey did not want to schedule at the end of June as there is a lot going on for the 8th graders.

There was concern discussed about the cost of the trip being expensive. Mr. Hovey explained that the trip is open for all students and financial assistance is offered.

110 students is an estimate of those attending it's usually 70-80% of the class, others that do not attend there are day activities planned.

The cost last year was \$970 and this year there was an increase of \$10.

A committee member was not comfortable with sending 13 year olds half way across the world and does not feel this is an appropriate distance to travel, also the cost of the trip being paid 100% by parents as these students are yet to young to have employment to help in the costs.

Dr. Harvey explained that this trip was supposed to happen last year but one chaperone could not attend due to personal reasons. He was approached by Ms. Sano stating that the students that were to attend last year are still very interested.
