## MEETING MINUTES FROM JOINT MEETING OF THE HAMILTON-WENHAM REGIONAL SCHOOL COMMITTEE AND THE WENHAM BOARD OF SELECTMEN

November 17, 2016

Wenham Board of Selectman Present:

School Committee Chair Stacey Metternick opened the School Committee session for interviewing Josh Liebow, Candidate for School Committee.

Wenham Board of Selectmen John Clemenzi opened the BOS meeting for the same

School Committee Chair Stacey Metternick presented questions to the candidate. Candidate's responses summarized in italics:

- Candidate's experience in serving on government boards/committees

  No service on government boards, but has served on for-profit boards
- How the candidate would develop his knowledge on oversight of Hamilton-Wenham Schools Through discussion with Dr. Harvey, former and current School Committee members
- Candidate's awareness of the role of the School Committee in terms of setting policy in order to facilitate administration's execution of said policy.

Is aware of the differing roles of School Committee vs. Administration

- Special skills the candidate brings to the position
  - Candidate's role at John Hancock involves analysis of financial structures of businesses, reviewing financial forecasts, both of which are pertinent to the School District.
- Availability to prepare for and participate in 2-4 meetings per month between general School Committee meetings and committee/working group meetings
  - Candidate is confident that he will have sufficient time to attend and prepare for his responsibilities to the School Committee.
- Candidate was asked about what he sees as the most critical issue(s) the School Committee

must address over the next three years.

Decline in enrollment requires budget to maintain the same quality of education; ensuring infrastructure is acceptable; ongoing funding

- Whether or not the candidate would seek election in April to extend his service

  Yes, if over the net 6 months he finds he can make a conribution and fulfill the responsibilities
- If the candidate is comfortable advocating for the concerns of the Hamilton-Wenham Regional School District at Town Meetings

  Yes

Discussion followed, with questions from Selectmen about number of Town Meetings attended (2 in Hamilton, which concerned the School District), length of time candidate has lived in Wenham (3 years).
